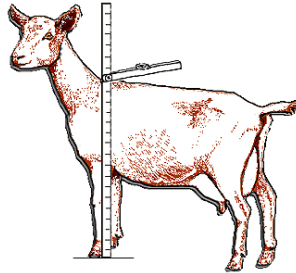

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE COMPLETING THIS CERTIFICATE

1. The animal MUST have permanent identification, NLIS Tag, Tattoo or Microchip.
2. The animal MUST be at least 3 years old, (minimum 6 large front teeth)
3. **The correct way to measure** this goat is to have it standing squarely on a flat even surface (Concrete is best). It should be as relaxed as possible and standing with its head in the natural upright position (as pictured).
4. The animal must be measured with a right angle device that has a built in spirit level to give the most accurate measurement.
5. A recent photo of the animal must be signed by the Veterinarian, AFTER the animal has been inspected.
6. Any animal may be inspected by a Veterinarian.
7. This form must be completed for
3yr / 4yr **ADULT REGISTRATION** or **UPGRADE** for
 - Females 46cm (18.1") & under.
 - Males 52cm (20.5") & under.
 - Bucks qualifying for Grade A or Purebred status.
