WELCOME

Welcome to the Australian Miniature Goat Registry, we hope your involvement with us will be a long and happy one. The AMGR is a privately owned registry working with the Miniature Goat Breeders Association of Australia Inc. operating a national database that was created in February 2000 to record details for animals used in the Australian Miniature Goat breeding program. A complete list of guidelines and the rules that all AMGR Breeders abide by is a great way to get you started. Breeders are expected to make themselves conversant with the Rules, Breed Standards, Grade System and Code of Ethics. Once you have been accepted as a member of the Miniature Goat Breeders Association of Australia Inc. you are eligible to register a Stud Prefix. You should do this as soon as possible if you have purchased pregnant AMGR registered goats, before the kids are born so they can be registered into your own stud name.

STUD PREFIX: Your Stud Prefix (Name of Stud) is for your exclusive use. It will precede the names of the animal's you register. When applying for a stud prefix, please submit two (2) different names in order of preference - we will make every effort to allocate you with your first choice unless that name has already been registered.

As a breeder who registers animals, you will receive a parentage / height verification certificate for each animal registered. This certificate offers future purchasers of your stock a standard, official document that contains up to three generations of parentage, height and type data. This certificate is the seller's proof of pedigree and will bring you a premium sale price above stock sold without one.

It is your responsibility to check that NLIS ear tags, tattoo marks or microchip identification corresponds with what is recorded on the animal's registration papers. This is essential, as incorrect or non-existent identification may revoke registration status of the animal(s). Discrepancies must be reported to the AMGR Secretary for correction, as soon as possible.

PERMANENT IDENTIFICATION: Breeders wishing to use TATTOO marking as a form of identification will be required to record a 2-3 character Stud Mark for registration purposes. Each animal bred by you must be marked with this in addition to an individual serial number, for identification, in accordance with the sequence of birth of each animal. Individual serial number should consist of a letter specifying year of birth followed by two or three digits indicating the sequence in which the animal was born on your stud, eg: H03, indicating the 3rd animal born on your stud in 2008. Green ink is recommended. The Registry also accepts MICROCHIPS as a permanent form of identification. Goats will NOT be eligible for entry into the Registry's Stud Book if they are not permanently marked and animals not carrying their recorded identification will have registration revoked.

STUD BOOK: The Registry maintains records of all animals recorded with the AMGR. The AMGR is currently working on the revised edition of the Stud Book and when published, it will be made available for a fee prescribed by the AMGR.

STUD BOOK: The Registry records the following Sections, Experimental & Established (G4+) Breeds;

Stud Prefixes

ELF: Grade D, C, B, A, Purebred, Herdbook

PIXIE: Grade D, C, B, A, Purebred, Herdbook

MUNCHKIN: Grade D, C, B, A, Purebred, Herdbook

NUWBY: Grade D, C, B, A, Purebred, Herdbook

Mini Angora: Grade D, C, B, A, Purebred, Herdbook

Overheight

The Registry will record the above Sections using recognized livestock grading up systems when adopted.

TRANSFERS: Application for transfer OR lease of any animal entered in the Registry's records MUST be forwarded, accompanied by the set fee, by the vendor or lessor to the AMGR Secretary on the prescribed form, duly completed within thirty (30) days of Sale or Lease. Transfer forms are printed on the reverse of the registration certificates. It is the responsibility of the vendor/s to furnish the purchaser/s with sales receipt, particulars of service, etc, for all stock sold as Registered Stock.

SERVICE CERTIFICATES: In any case where the services of a Buck owned or leased by another breeder is obtained or a doe is sold in kid, a Service Certificate MUST be lodged with the application to register for the resultant progeny.

STOCK BREEDING RECORDS: As a registered breeder you will be required to keep an accurate written record of all your operations connected with the purchase, breeding and sale of goats registered with the AMGR.
